



Unit 3 Performance Assessment Task: International Organizations Inquiry

Social Studies 20-1

Background:

The extent to which history is doomed to repeat itself depends on our ability to critically review the past and evaluate the factors that led to success or failures. Similarly, one can look towards the history of international organizations and determine the best practices and shortcomings of achieving the objectives of internationalism.

Critical/Essential Question:

How effective are international organizations effective at promoting internationalism?

Task:

In your groups, you will be assigned one of the following international organizations to inquire into. Prepare a 10minute presentation on the organization, and provide an infographic for your peers so that the information can be shared. Include in your presentation an evaluation on what factors make an organization effective in its pursuit of internationalism.

- United Nations
- World Council of Indigenous Peoples
- European Union
- L'Organisation Internationale de la Francophone
- Arctic Council
- International NGO of choice

Your presentation and infographic should include:

- **A brief** overview of the organizations – their history, goals, objectives, structure
- **Precise** successes in internationalism – provide specific examples
- Some **insightful** criticisms of the organization – provide **thorough** discussion of evidence
- Evaluation of what made them effective (or ineffective) – have a position/take home message

Feel free to use various audio/visual media in your presentation and make your infographic as creative and artistic as you want, as long as it does not take away accessibility to the content. Your infographic can be in the form of a poster, brochure, etc.
